

# DEMOLITION

## Home or Commercial Building Waste Disposal-Wray Gulch Landfill

Includes demolition of a load-bearing structural member and demolition projects larger than: **Single Family Residential Dwelling** - 32 sf, 50 lf (pipe), or the equivalent volume of a 55 gal. drum, or **All Other Areas** - 160 sf, 260 lf (pipe) or the equivalent volume of a 55 gal. drum.

For mobile homes, see Mobile Home Checklist

**You will need a county or town demolition permit.**

State certified asbestos inspector inspects building and submits **Demolition Notification Application Form** to state.

Is there a reportable amount of asbestos in the facility to be demolished?

Owner provides landfill manager with copy of Inspection report and approved Demolition Notification and may dispose of waste.

Contractor/Owner will fill out & submit a **State Asbestos Abatement Notification**. State will send back approval/disapproval.

**Haulers: To avoid liability, call landfill manager to ensure owner is following these instructions before placing dumpster on-site.**

For Friable, Certified Asbestos Contractor must abate, haul and dispose ACM according to RBC Op. Plan.

For Non-Friable, wrap, seal & label material according to RBC Op. Plan.
